



RESOLUTION NO. 220-2004

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION TO DECLARE A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY REGARDING THE UNSANITARY CONDITIONS OF THE SPIDER LAKE-LITTLE SLUICE AREA, ADJACENT TO THE RUBICON TRAIL

WHEREAS, the unregulated use of the Spider Lake-Little Sluice area, southerly of and adjacent to the Rubicon Trail has resulted in the degradation of an environmentally sensitive area;

WHEREAS, there are no toilet facilities available in said area, resulting in a significant amount of human fecal waste deposited on and around the Spider Lake-Little Sluice area;

WHEREAS, the amount of human fecal waste poses a health & safety threat to the users of the Rubicon Trail and a threat to adjacent lakes and streams, which in turn flow into the American River watershed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors does hereby declare a State of Local Emergency exists in association with the use of the Spider Lake-Little Sluice area, effective July 13, 2004, as authorized under Government Code subsection 8558 (c);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Health and Safety Code, Section 101470, "preventive measures" are hereby directed to abate, remove and correct the public health hazard that has evolved on the Rubicon Trail; and further;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, said Spider Lake-Little Sluice area (as shown on the attached map), southerly of and adjacent to the Rubicon Trail shall be closed to the public for a period of 120 days; however, such closure shall not affect the use of the Rubicon Trail as a thoroughfare.
